Looking forward

Work on site for the upcoming season will start in November 2021, but preparations of the 30-men strong team of engineers, craftsmen and artists in Germany are already in full swing. Overnight accommodation in the IGLOOTEL 2022 will be available for individual travelers in "Exclusive IGLOOs". Friends, couples, and families have the opportunity to spend the night with up to 6 people in adequate "romantic IGLOOs".

Visitors and guests of IGLOOTEL can expect a unique experience that creates long-lasting memories. Whether alone, with your partner, friends, family, or colleagues – an overnight stay at IGLOOTEL Lapland is a real treat. Dreams come true when you spend the night cuddled up in cozy polar sleeping bags in a real IGLOO made of snow and ice. In addition to the so-called sleeping IGLOOs, visitors can expect a cool Ice Bar or – after a relaxing sauna session – look out for the fascinating northern lights in a hot whirlpool under the open arctic sky. Artfully designed event IGLOOs not only invite you to evening events or product presentations, but also offer an extraordinary setting for e.g. exhibitions, weddings or birthday parties.

So far and yet so close

Overnight stays in snow and ice as well as warm overnight accommodation in the hotel rooms of Hotel Laponia, which are characterized by a modern Nordic design, will be available 7 days a week and are easily accessible with FlyCar direct-flights to Arvidsjaur from Munich, Stuttgart, Hanover and Frankfurt-Hahn. Short trips to the winter wonderland can be booked from mid-January to mid-March 2022 in the following combinations: Friday – Monday (3 nights – from all 4 airports) and Friday – Wednesday (5 nights), Wednesday – Monday (5 nights) and Wednesday – Wednesday (7 nights) ex/to Munich and/or Hanover. Visitors also benefit in terms of price when booking a flight via FlyCar in combination with a visit or an overnight stay in IGLOOTEL thanks to attractive special conditions. Moreover, the established FlyCar hygiene concept as well as the COVID promise of our flight partner provide the necessary safety aspect (more information: www.fly-car.de).
